TEACHING

- **BS4458 – EPORTFOLIOS IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (FORMERLY: CAPSTONE COURSE)**
This is a capstone course that will assist the student in the development of a professional e-Portfolio that is reflective of the student's professional goals, objectives, and personal experiences and that is designed as a valuable tool for career progression.
- **CO1403 - MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEMS IN BUSINESS**
A survey and analysis of the use of management information systems in the business environment. Modules cover the basic concepts and terminology of business data processing including computer systems and components, spreadsheets, database management, accounting, Internet applications, and project management.
- **CO2410 – DATABASE MANAGEMENT**
Database Management will involve the understanding, application, and design of database management projects to fulfill business applications. This course will include interactive database team projects and management design of database requirements.
- **CO2412 – CREATING A BUSINESS PRESENCE ON THE WEB**
In this course, students will program multimedia Web pages with hypertext links, tables, frames, forms, cascading style sheets utilizing HTML and XHTML. JavaScript is introduced. HTML, XHTML, and JavaScript are used to design and control dynamic content and layout, control mouse and keyboard events, utilize sound, and manipulate graphics.
- **CO2416 – TECHNOLOGY ENHANCED COMMUNICATIONS I**
This course is designed to provide the student with basic word processing skills. Emphasis is on using software features to create, edit, and print common office communications. Upon completion, the student should be able to demonstrate the ability to use industry-standard software to generate appropriately formatted, accurate, and attractive business communications such as memos, letters, and reports.
- **CO2422 – COMMUNICATING VIA THE INTERNET**
Introduces the student to the Internet and provides the student with an excellent opportunity to understand, investigate, and explore the Internet as it is interconnected to Wide Area Networks. The student will learn how to use communications software to access the many resources available on the network.
- **CO2446 - OPEN SOURCE BUSINESS SYSTEMS I**
This course is a review of the open source applications and systems *available* to support organizational systems in business, education, and SOHO (Small-Office, Home-Office). An "entry-level" technical research paper is required in this course. (Note: you will also be presented with the installation of a "dual-boot" process, as well as a virtual system install. Details will be presented in Learning Community I).

TEACHING (cont'd)

- **CO2447 - OPEN SOURCE BUSINESS SYSTEMS II**
A continuation of the fundamentals established in CO2446. This course looks at advanced strategies, details of enterprise systems, and additional techniques/technologies in terms of actual systems installation and applications.
- **CO3430 – WEB DESIGN/APPLICATIONS MANAGEMENT**
This course expands on HTML, XHTML, and XML concepts. Students design and create web sites with multiple non-linear pages using industry standard web design applications. Web site management strategies and security issues are also covered. Prerequisites: CO2412 and CO3424 preferred but not required.
- **RS6539 – Research and Evaluation**
A study that provides a broad understanding of types of research, basic statistics, research report development, research implementation, program evaluation, needs assessment, writing a research proposal, and ethical and legal considerations in doing research. Students will develop a research plan incorporating the basic concepts addressed in the course.

- **CIS171 - FUNDAMENTALS OF UNIX/LINUX I**
 Included in this course are skills development for OS installation and setup, recompile techniques, system configuration settings, file/folder structures and types, run levels, basic network applications, and scripting. Additionally, the course presents security features from an administrative and user consideration.

- **CIS172 - FUNDAMENTALS OF UNIX/LINUX II**
 This course is a continuation of DPT171 and includes web applications, integrated network configurations, file transfer, server administration, system controls, iptables/firewall to secure Unix/Linux systems, and strategic user-group applications specific to administrative network control.

- **CIS264 – BUSINESS APPLICATIONS**
 Prior programming training is put to use in implementing a practical business application such as accounts receivable, accounts payable, payroll, or other business system.

- **CIS270 – Cisco CCNA I**
 After completing this course the student will be able to: identify the functions of each layer of the OSI reference model; describe data link and network addresses; define and describe the function of the MAC address; explain the five conversion steps of data encapsulation; describe the different classes of IP addresses and subnetting; identify the functions of the TCP/IP network-layer protocols.

- **CIS271 – Cisco CCNA II**
 After completing this course the student will be able to: prepare the initial configuration of a router and enable IP; control router passwords and identification; configure IP addresses; add the RIP and IGRP routing protocols to a configuration.

- **CIS272 – Cisco CCNA III**
 After completing this course, the student will be able to: describe LAN segmentation using bridges, routers, and switches; distinguish between cut-through and store and forward LAN switching; describe the operation of the Spanning Tree Protocol and its benefits; describe the benefits of virtual LANs.

- **CIS273 – Cisco CCNA IV**
 After completing this course the student will be able to: differentiate between LAPB, Frame Relay, ISDN, HDLC, PPP, and DDR; list commands to configure Frame Relay LMIs, maps, and sub-interfaces; identify PPP operations to encapsulate WAN data on Cisco routers; identify ISDN protocols, function groups, reference points, and channels; describe Cisco's implementation of ISDN BRI.

- **CIS280 – NETWORK SECURITY**
This course provides a study of threats to network security and methods of securing a computer network from such threats. Topics included in this course are security risks, intrusion detection, and methods of securing authentication, network access, remote access, Web access, and wired and wireless network communications.
- **CIS284 – DPT INTERNSHIP**
Emphasis is placed on the student’s “real world” work experience as it integrates academics with practical applications that relate meaningfully to careers in the computer discipline.
- **CIS291 – CASE STUDY IN COMPUTER SCIENCE**
This course is a case study involving the assignment of a complete system development project for analysis, programming, implementation, and documentation. Topics include planning system analysis and design, programming techniques, coding and documentation. Upon completion, students should be able to design, code, test and document a comprehensive computer information system.
- **CIS294 – SPECIAL TOPICS**
This course allows study of currently relevant computer science topics, with the course being able to be repeated for credit for each different topic covered. Course content will be determined by the instructor and will vary according to the topic being covered. Upon completion, the student will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the course topic through completion of assignments and appropriate tests.
- **CIS296 – SPECIAL TOPICS**
This course allows study of currently relevant computer science topics, with the course being able to be repeated for credit for each different topic covered. Course content will be determined by the instructor and will vary according to the topic being covered. Upon completion, the student will be able to demonstrate specified skills.
- **CIS299 – DIRECTED STUDIES IN COMPUTER SCIENCE**
This course allows independent study under the direction of an instructor. Topics to be included in the course material will be approved by the instructor prior to or at the beginning of the class. Upon completion, the student will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the topics as specified by the instructor.
