ade in the Image of God. Think about that for a moment. A Holy God making us in His image, according to His likeness. Me, just an ordinary person, someone who has struggled—and continues to struggle—with life's issues, fallen down so many times that my knees look like pine knots and scarred beyond help—made in the image of God. More precisely, "Let us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over..." Speedbump!!! Rule over... subdue the earth ... rule over. Sounds like broken English, eh? Broken English is not what's broken, but our image and our 'rule over' outcomes! God wants our image to reflect Him, to 'walk in the shoes' of Jesus (God, use this to Glorify You) so that we are a mirror of His image. While we are unique in fingerprints, pounds gained and lost in a year, the very hairs on our heads, and our quirks (yes, you know for a fact that we have quirks, Dear Christian friends), God desires that our walk with Him should be in His image. This includes our actions and how we perceive ourselves in comparison to others, neighbors, coworkers, family members, etc. IN other words, does our *personal* image make us think that maybe we don't measure up? Surely this does not invade the territory of self-worth and human being value, does it? It might, but let's focus on image.

What is an image? Is it how we see ourselves or how others see us? *Are we self-conscious about our image???* Let me preface this by saying that I'm not looking to highlight any 'complex' that we may have, but just asking a rhetorical question. Like, do you care what people see you do—in public, private, both or neither? There is an old saying about a tree falling in the forest. I retrieved this from the Internet; *Treehugger*: "It's a riddle that's been twisting brains for generations: If a tree falls in the woods and no one is around to hear it, does

it make a sound? The answer, at least according to a comprehensive study of nature's noises, is 'yes' -- but it may be drowned out by the hum of a motor vehicle." Now I'm not sure what the motor vehicle has to do with this idea, but let me tell you why I included this: "If a person does something when no one is looking, does it make it right if it is something that is wrong in the first place?" According to a Holy Comprehensive Study published in the Most Holy of all Books, The Bible, well, I think you get the point. Read the story that follows and then 'let's talk.'

Several years ago, a new preacher moved to Houston, Texas. Some weeks after he arrived, he had occasion to ride the bus from his home to the downtown area. When he sat down, he discovered that the driver had accidentally given him a quarter too much change. As he considered what to do, he thought to himself, "You'd better give the quarter back. It would be wrong to keep it." Then he thought, "Oh, forget it, it's only a quarter. Who would worry about this little amount? Anyway, the bus company gets too much fare; they will never miss it. Accept it as a 'gift from God' and keep quiet." When his stop came, he paused momentarily at the door, then he handed the quarter to the driver and said, "Here, you gave me too much change." The driver with a smile replied, "Aren't you the new preacher in town? I have been thinking lately about going to worship somewhere. I just wanted to see what you would do if I gave you too much change. I'll see you at church on Sunday." When the preacher stepped off of the bus, he literally grabbed the nearest light pole, held on, and said, "Oh God, I almost sold your Son for a quarter." Our lives are the only Bible some people will ever read. This is a really scary example of how much people watch us as Christians and will put us to the test! Always be on guard and remember that you carry the name of Christ in your Heart, Mind, Body, and Spirit wherever you go in life. If you go to a movie, you carry the Name of Christ; when you drive, you carry the Name of Christ; and every place you and I go. If we are bornagain, we are (or we should be) an image of Christ:

Watch your thoughts; they become words.
Watch your words; they become actions.
Watch your actions; they become habits.
Watch your habits; they become character.
Watch your character; it becomes your destiny.

Are we not all passengers on this Bus? Do we not have a responsibility to act in the image of God at all times? Are we going to be successful? We are His witness 24x7, and whether we realize it or not—whether that tree makes any sound or not—when we fall, it makes a noise, and God hears it. When we stumble before others, we make a noise, and they 'hear' it with their eyes. Ever hear this: 'What you do speaks so loudly, I can't hear what you're saying.' Ever hear that truth before? If you recall, I titled this chapter, Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons. You might be asking right about now, "Ken, sometimes you are like a whirlwind, you move here, then there, and you lose me!" Hey, no problema! I get lost myself sometimes too! Here's a bit of "clearity" for you to cogitate over: God made us in His image, we live our Christian lives before others; therefore, we reflect God in Christ, making us Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons. Now, what was hard about that? Okay, you did know the moon is not a celestial body with its own light source, right? © Like, the sun shines, the moon reflects the light. As Christians, the Son Shines, the Christian reflects The Light. When we are given too much change from a purchase, we give it back. On the other hand, if we are charged more than what was advertised or what was on the purchase ticket, we ensure that the entity charges us correctly or gives it back as it is right as well. What's the point? As you read in the Life Application Verses, God made us in His image and likeness; He also gave us "...rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth" (underline mine). I don't know about you, but God gave us a responsibility that is radical, heavy, and WOW! As his 'primary' creation, He gave us dominion over the Earth and we are to be Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons. We should reflect what is Good, because God is Good in All Things. We should reflect the Saving Grace in Jesus Christ, because God gave us rule over every living thing—and that INCLUDES ourselves—whether we are lost, saved, confused, irrational, Democrat, Republican,

Independent, homeless, rich, middle-class, Black, White, Brown, educated, illiterate, American, Jewish, Arab, Scandinavian, a fast driver, a slow driver, a stranger, a friend, a family member, shoppers at Wal-Mart, shoppers at Saks Fifth Avenue, or just ordinary people like me. What is this 'rule thing' in the Life Application Verses?

First, as our God said, it includes all living things on the Earth. We are not only to rule over them, but to also be caretakers for them, as well. It seems like every day we hear of a species becoming extinct or soon to be extinct. Rule over them includes being good stewards of the resources of this Earth—living and otherwise. Secondly, rule over all living things surely includes those who are in Positions of Power. For example, Presidents, Kings, Congress, bosses, and so forth—do not these individuals also have the responsibility to rule over others, and provide responsible care for their well-being? I'm not talking about doing for them to make them subservient, but about helping them to become independent thinkers, achievers, and productive. It's like the saying, "Give a person a fish and you will do so every day of their lives; teach them to fish, and you have given them freedom to do other things and care for themselves for the rest of their lives." (The saying is actually, 'Give a man a fish and you feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish and you feed him for a lifetime.') If these leaders are Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons, how can our world not be a better place than it would have been otherwise? Today, as much of the Earth is not about caring for people but about domination over them, we Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons need to shine that much brighter to the world around us. We may very well be the only Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moon they will ever see...

Chicago has an epidemic of killings. I just read a news release from a wire service in which a mother lost her 5 children, 6-and-younger, in a fire. Iran and North Korea want nuclear capability so that they might rule more powerfully over their people and threaten other nations

(mainly, Israel and the U.S.). Drunk drivers killed several people since I started this particular chapter, and countless others since I began this book. How many abortions have been concluded between this moment (2016) and when God first moved me to write these words? (God knows every one of them by 'name.') Hateful murders for any number of reasons grow almost exponentially in certain corners of the world. Christians are persecuted by the scores in nations that claim to be 'Nations of Peace.' And, to think, God created us in His image and gave us rule over every living thing? Are there enough Heavenly Minded, Earthly Good Moons to go around? Can we shine the Light bright enough so that this mixed-up, crazed world will ever be able to see? God Help Us! It seems that our world is beyond hope!
