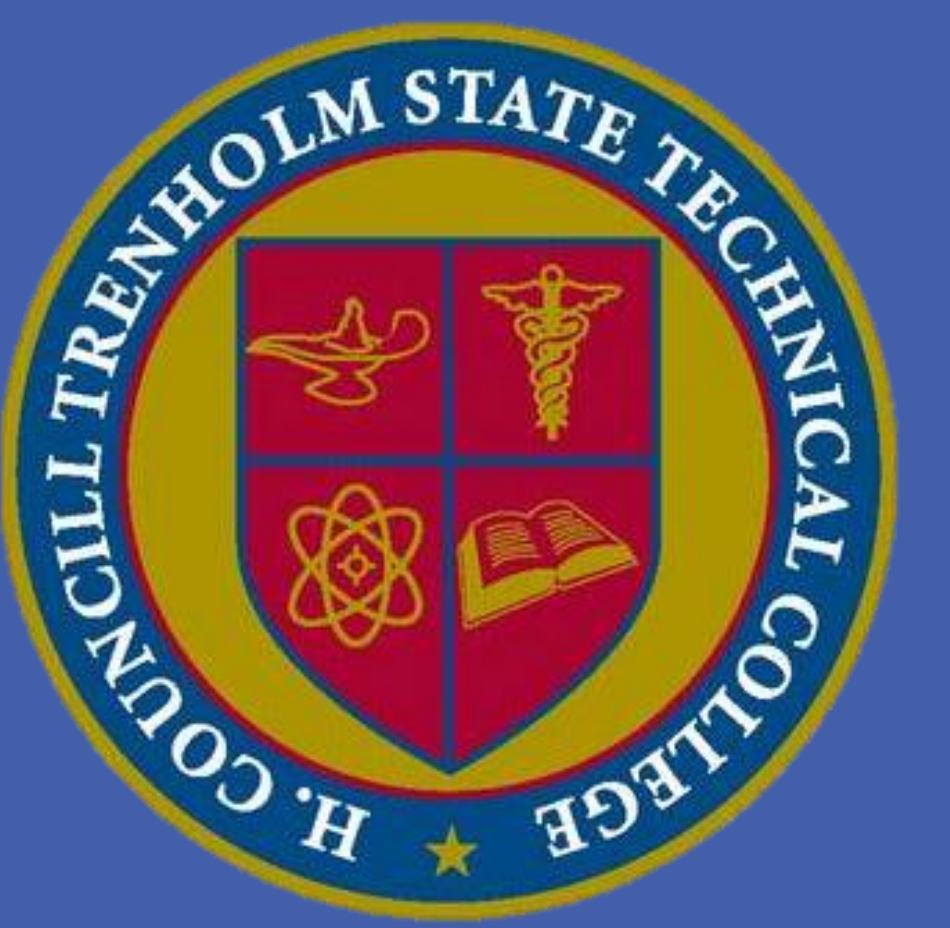

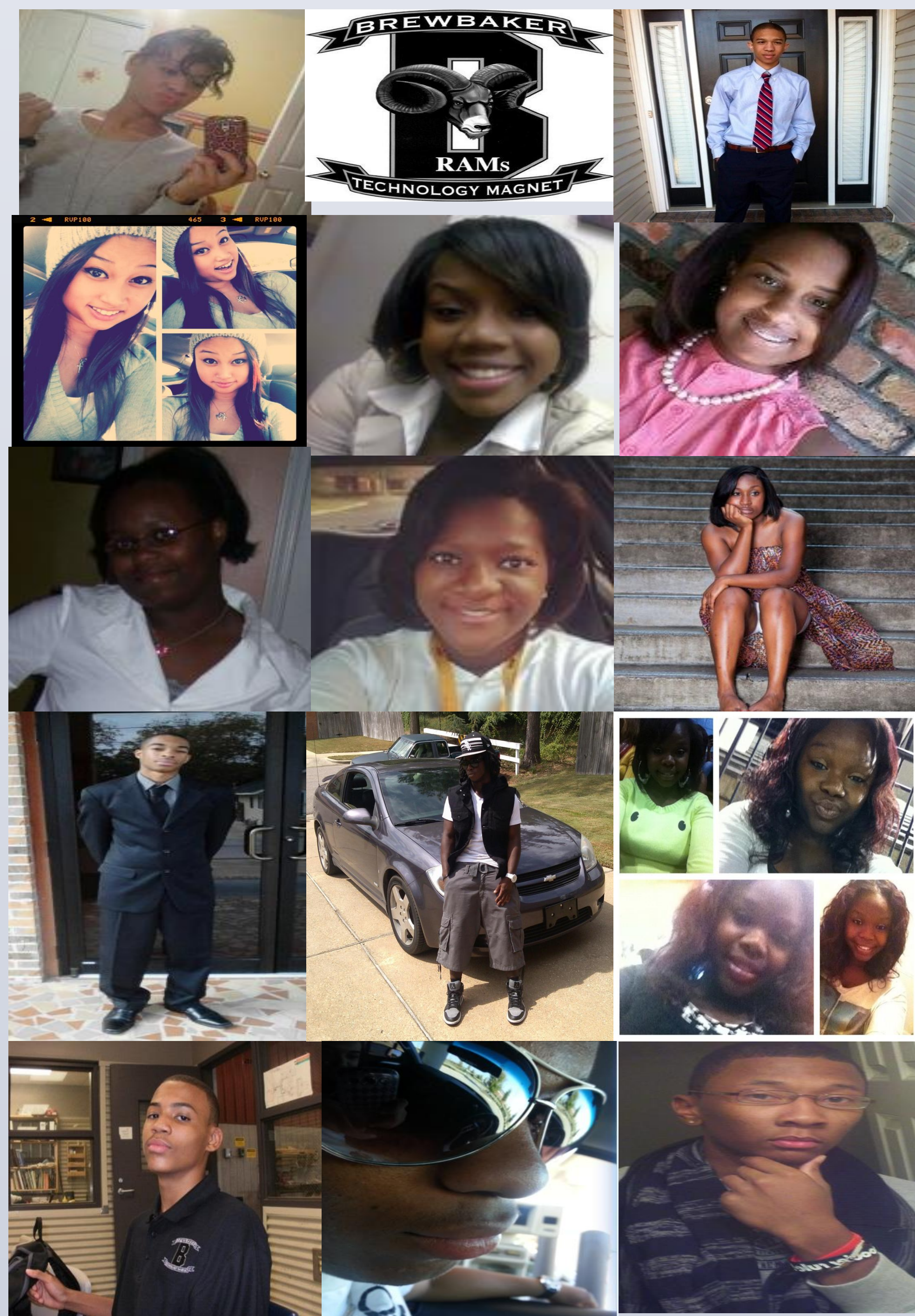

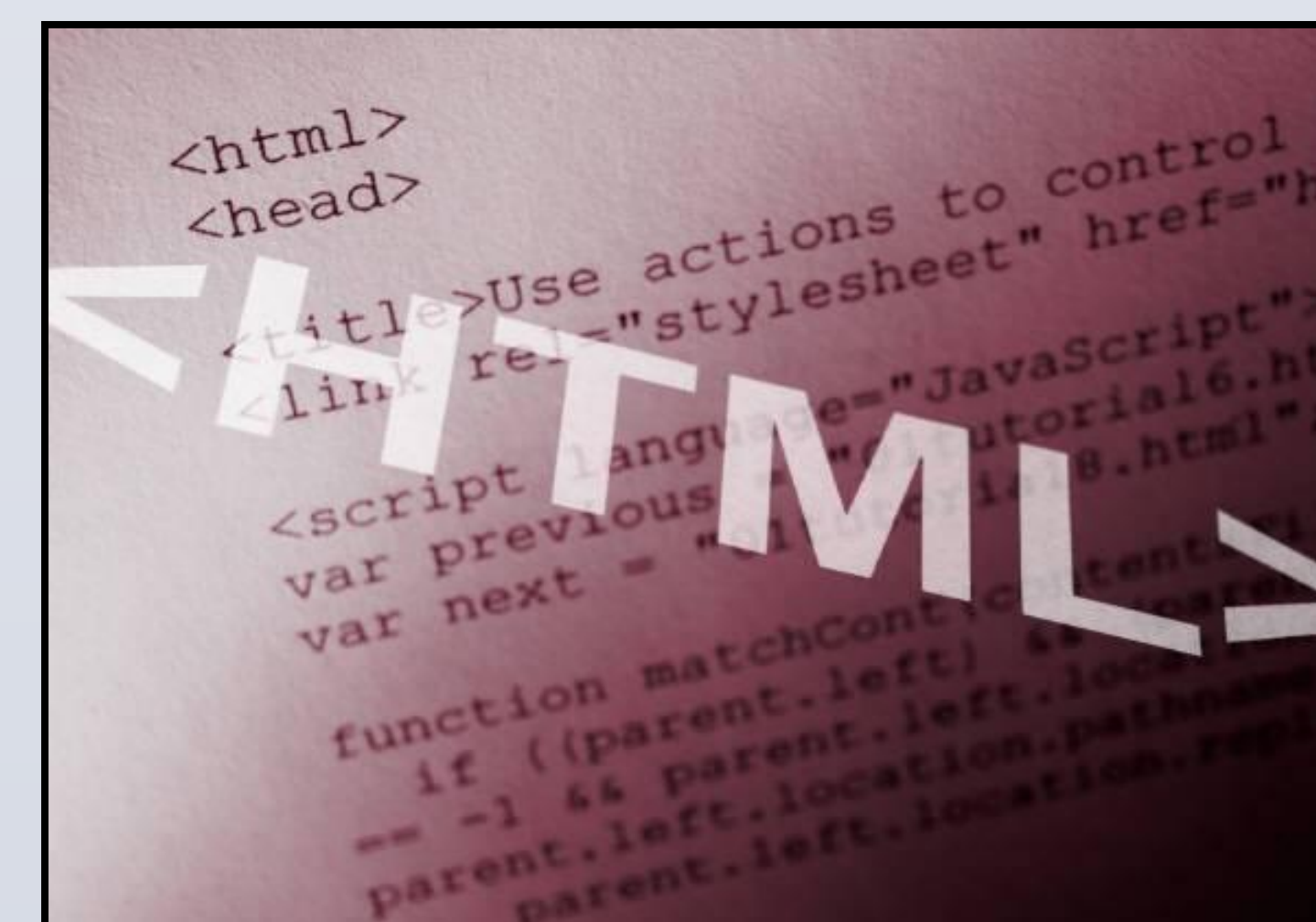
Life At Trenholm

DPT 207 Intro to Web Development

Our instructor was Dr. Ken Scott. In our course, DPT208 Introduction to Web Development, we learned how to create HTML code using an Adobe computer application known as “DreamWeaver.” Moreover, we learned what an ePortfolio is, and how to create one. We learned that the use of “traditional style” resumes are becoming obsolete. Therefore, employers utilize ePortfolios to determine a potential employees skill, past work experience, and involvement in the community.



In our second part of the course, we studied HTML and learned how to develop HTML code. Using the HTML code, we were able to create a web page. Our first webpage in this course was the J-Prop Shop; we developed it using the guidelines from the book. We also learned that in order for a webpage to be viewable, the html code has to be exact; it can’t show any errors.

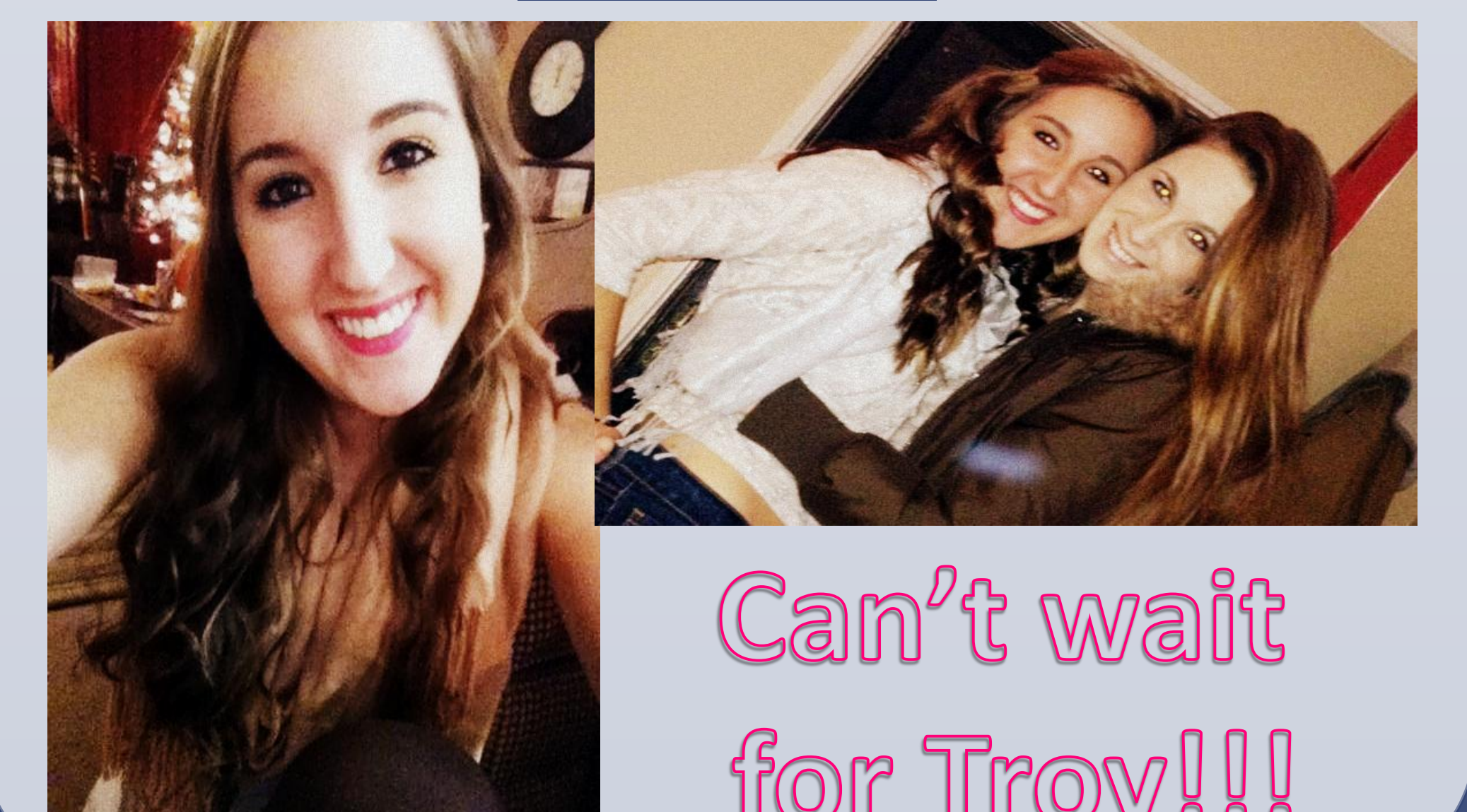
