Presentation Title: The World Wide Web Wow: Web 2.0 Technologies That Significantly Enhance Teaching-Learning

25 Word Abstract:

This presentation will demonstrate various instructional technologies that will provide significant support to successful teaching-learning activities in the classroom, e.g. Flickr, Google, LiveStream, etc.

Outline:

- 1. The presentation will be presented in two back-to-back, concurrent 60-minute sessions to provide sufficient coverage of the types of technologies to be demonstrated.
- 2. An initial overview of the session will be provided in the first 15 minutes or less and include an open-ended discussion to stimulate interest in the topics/technologies to be presented.
- 3. The technologies will be demonstrated live via the Internet and from remote locations configured prior to the start of the conference. The applications demonstrated include shareware and open-source systems.
- 4. A sampling list is provided here: Flickr, or image sharing; Google Apps-Office Apps; LiveStream-Video capture and instructional use; Facebook, or networking information/website substitute; MacIntosh iLife interface with web apps; Blogs and PowerPoint apps; and additional shared and free systems/applications;
- 5. The expected outcome of these two 60-minute, back-to-back sessions is to provide instructors with teaching tools that can enhance and improve the teaching-learning process in the classroom. It is noted that these instructional resources improve the learning outcomes due to the interactive nature of the technologies being utilized; in other words, it is these various technologies that challenge students to learn the material by using technologies that many of them are familiar th or seek to know more about. The presentation will bridge teaching-learning with techniques and technologies that motivate instructors to teach and students to learn.
