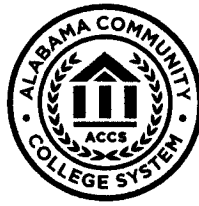

ALABAMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM  
Appointment of Representatives to the Alabama Holocaust Commission

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended "That the Alabama State Board of Education appoint Ms. LeAnn Judah with Lurleen B. Wallace Community College, Dr. Kenneth Scott with H. Councill Trenholm State Technical College, and Mr. Bill Watt with Bevill State Community College as representatives of the Alabama Community College System to the Alabama Holocaust Commission as provided by state law."

FISCAL CONSIDERATION

Members of the Alabama Holocaust Commission serve without compensation. They are entitled by law to reimbursement for all necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with state travel regulations. Expenses will be paid by the Alabama Holocaust Commission.

RATIONALE

Act 99-404 created the Alabama Holocaust Commission, whose purpose is to survey, design, encourage, and promote implementation of ongoing Holocaust education and awareness programs of the Holocaust throughout the State of Alabama. The Commission is composed of twenty members, five of whom are representatives from the Alabama Community College System appointed by the Alabama State Board of Education. The five members serve indefinitely at the pleasure of the Board. Due to the resignations of Dr. Prentice Chandler and Ms. Kelley Haynes Pearce and the retirement of Dr. Amy Porche, the Chair of the Commission has asked that the Board fill those vacancies. The colleges were surveyed. Ms. LeAnn Judah with Lurleen B. Wallace Community College, Dr. Kenneth Scott with H. Councill Trenholm State Technical College, and Mr. Bill Watt with Bevill State Community College have been selected as the replacements.
