Capitol Heights ended their effort with the close of school a year ago. Charlsetta left, the principal left, and we left. There were about 25 kids in that group at CH. But in February of that year, as you might remember, we started another program at Carver Elementary under Ms. Jackie Chappell, a parent volunteer. At the end of her first year she had 35 kids enrolled. Jackie picked up where she left off this year, and doubled the enrollment to 53 as of this, the last week of school.

A Food Bank rep met with Jackie and me this week. She can not have been more impressed with what Jackie had done than I was. Jackie used the money we had left over to buy food all year. In addition, she started raising money on her own, and at the end of the year had \$300 to begin next year's work. Furthermore, every family in her program received a turkey and all the fixings for Thanksgiving. Jackie's stewardship of our program and your money filled me with admiration for her efforts and her success.
